Steps, Traditions and Concepts

Al-Anon's program of recovery is based on the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of Alcoholics Anonymous. The Steps are the foundation for personal recovery and the Traditions help groups sustain their unity and fellowship.

Step 4

Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.

Tradition 4

Each group should be autonomous, except in matters affecting another group or Al-Anon or AA as a whole.

Concept 4

Participation is the key to harmony

Alcohol Awareness Month is a nationwide campaign to raise public awareness about the use of alcohol and its effects on individuals, families and communities. It provides opportunities for Al-Anon and Alateen groups to reach out to families and friends of alcoholics who are suffering and still unaware of the Al-Anon program of recovery.



Al-Anon Family Groups is a "worldwide fellowship that offers a program of recovery for the families and friends of alcoholics, whether or not the alcoholic recognizes the existence of a drinking problem or seeks help."
Alateen is part of the AL-Anon fellowship designed for the younger relatives and friend of alcoholics through the teen yars."
