

HAPPY ANNIVERSARY AL-ANON FAMILY GROUPS

Al-Anon started as a grass roots movement in 1939-1940 when families of alcoholics began meeting informally in private homes for many reasons. These meetings over time evolved into a structured program focusing on recovery from the effects of alcohol on the families of alcoholics. By 1951, with the approval and support of Alcoholics Anonymous, 87 known family groups were invited to join in a new fellowship of family & friends of alcoholics. They then voted on and accepted the name of *Al-Anon Family Groups*. And the rest is history!

Other times I was living my worst fears and HP gave me strength, courage and eventually acceptance and peace.

LOIS'S STORY

began to wonder why I was not as happy as I ought to be, since the one thing I had been yearning for all my married life had come to pass. Then one Sunday, Bill asked me if I was ready to go to the meeting with him. To my astonishment as well as his, I burst forth with, "Damn your old meetings!" and then threw a shoe as hard as I could.

This surprising display of temper over nothing pulled me up short and made me start to analyze my own attitudes. By degrees I saw that I had been wallowing in self-pity, that I resented the fact that Bill and I never spent any time together anymore, and then I was left alone while he was off somewhere scouting up new drunks or working with old ones. I felt on the outside... My pride was hurt by the fact that a friend, another alcoholic, had been able to do for Bill in a short time what I had tried and failed to do all our married life.

My life's purpose of sobering up Bill, which had made me feel desperately needed, had vanished. As I begin to be honest with myself I recognized how greatly Bill had developed spiritually... I decided to strive for my own spiritual growth. I use the same principles as he did to learn how to change my attitudes.

Several years later, Bill and I found that strained relations such as ours often developed in families after the first starry eyed period of sobriety was over. We were heartsick and puzzled to discover that, though alcoholics were recovering through this wonderful new program, their home lives were often difficult. We began to learn how many adjustments had to be made and that the partner of the alcoholic also needed to live by a spiritual program.

Soon, small groups composed of the family members of alcoholics in A.A. sprang up all over the country. They began to meet informally... for a variety of purposes but eventually evolved into focusing on recovery from the effects of a family member's alcoholism.

Al-Anon cofounder Lois W. passed away on October 5, 1988. She was 97 years old and had worked to help the families of alcoholics for more than 50 years.

Lois W. and the Pioneers Audio Interview

In June 1982, Lois W., Al-Anon's cofounder, met with Henrietta S., the first General Secretary of the Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters, and Margaret D., the first Editor of The Forum.

They shared their recollections of Al-Anon's early years in an interview that was later excerpted in the Lois W. and the Pioneers DVD (AV-24).

At a running time of 110 minutes, the recording is far more extensive and detailed than the 22-minute DVD version, and is presented here in two parts.

To the newcomer, it is suggested they attend 6 different meetings because each one has its own flavor. In 1998, the Serenity Seekers was organized literally around flavor. Karole D. needed a lunchtime meeting close to where she worked and was joined by 4 other working women- Allison, Sherry, Alexis and Jennifer. Initially, they came together as a discussion group meeting at St John's Parish Life Center. They made a flyer, announced its formation at other meetings and registered with WSO in 1999. Later a Beginners meeting was added a half hour earlier increasing attendance to the regular meeting.

The format has changed over the years. Beginning as a discussion group, it evolved into **Serenity Seekers Step and Study, AFG**; not only are the Steps studied but also the Traditions and Concepts. The book, *Paths to Recovery* is used in which each chapter is read in full and the significance of the stories discussed. Only when all the searching questions at the end of each chapter have been answered do they move on to the next chapter. A more in-depth study of the Concepts was added and in the words of a member back in 2010, "it allowed them to get to the 'good stuff' ...where they could really understand how these seemingly dry words have such an impact in our lives".

Today, due to COVID-19, **Serenity Seekers Step & Study, AFG** has suspended their meetings. They look forward to the day when they can come together again, in person, in the Al-Anon Family.

One of the spiritual symbols of Al-Anon is the transformative butterfly. It can take a Monarch butterfly 5 generations to make the round trip pilgrimage from the Sierra Madre Mountains in Mexico, north to as far away as eastern Canada and back again. Each generation lives very different lives than their parents, grandparents and great-grandparents and yet it is in their DNA that somehow each generation continues on its primary journey of going back to its origin of safety, renewal and community.*

The members of the **Friday Noon, AFG** meeting are very similar to the Monarch butterfly. Their journey is very different from their parent's and grandparent's. It is a journey to a place they had never imagined where safety, renewal and community are offered because of those who came before them.

When a long time member was asked why she keeps coming back to this particular meeting, she said, "...because of the shares. They are deep and meaningful." Another member remembers hearing the meeting referred to as "like being in God's living room."

There are no records of who started the **Friday Noon, AFG** meeting in May of 1985 and it doesn't matter. What matters is that through working the Al-Anon program today's members discover that it is possible to create a better life for themselves and future generations as long as they keep coming back.
