Our Fall Assembly has determined that **AREA 10**'s projected expenses for 2023 will be about \$44,000. There are 250 meetings in our Area. If each group donated \$45 per quarter (\$15 a month or \$3.50 a week) Area 10 could meet their expenses.

DISTRICT 159 projected expenses for 2023 will be about \$4,000. There are 24 active meetings in our District. If each group donated \$48 per quarter (\$16 a month or \$3.50 a week) our District could meet their expenses.

When I came to Naples as a full-time resident in 2018 in search of an Al-Anon family, I had the opportunity to attend 90 meetings in 90 days. One of my favorite days was Thursday as I could attend DISCOVERING CHOICES, AFG,

take a break and then go across the hall at the 24 Hour Club and attend the Beginner's meeting. Sometime at the end of the year the GR, Susan Kay, approached me and explained that the Beginners meeting had been supported by the DISCOVERING CHOICES, AFG group, and attendance and support was required to keep supporting the meeting.

As I shared this with the regular attendees at the meeting, I found out that ShoShanna had been one of the members to start this group years before. She signed up immediately to lead the meeting for the whole month of January 2019. Several other members stepped up to attend business meetings. By Fall we had a WSO number, a GR, a literature volunteer and a treasurer.

We utilized the WSO format of six meetings and chose to combined them into four rotating topics. We focus on welcoming Newcomers, the first three Steps, the three C's

and the slogans. Our group conscience chose to allow newcomers to ask questions and invited members to offer their courage, strength and hope in response. We are mindful that although this is an exception to the practice of no Crøss-Talk, the leader guides the meeting and it's "how it works" in our meetings.

We average 15-20 people in the couch room even in summer, and the numbers often double during season. There is almost always a newcomer, often several at each meeting. Newcomers expressed how they "felt welcomed and have found solutions a little sooner in their journey." Many say it is their home group as they remember "it was the first time they felt they weren't alone, and that there were others who shared their experience and offered to help."

It is bittersweet that there is always another Newcomer who walks through the door week after week. We are aware of what brought them through the door. We are also very glad they found us so that they can begin to Recover.
