Good personal leadership at all service levels is a necessity. In the field of world service the board of trustees assumes the primary leadership.





#### Man's Rejection is God's Protection

(How Does Rejection Protect Me?)

Growing up in an alcoholic and dysfunctional family affected my self-image. My initial reaction to a recent rejection was sadness followed by negative feelings about myself-not being good enough, flawed, confused, and angry with "me".

My sponsor pointed out that when I become negative about me, I am rejecting myself. I am trying to get others to love me when maybe I don't love myself enough. With the help of my sponsor, I realized that I was not paying attention to what "I" wanted. I was so focused on their needs that I had dismissed my own wants and needs. I was not being honest with myself about what I wanted but was not getting. I was settling for something that did not truly align with my own desires and values.

Al-Anon suggests that my experiences in life are about learning; there is no growth without change and loving myself.

I slowly began to see that this rejection was my Higher Power's way of teaching and protecting me. Today I have confidence that I will move through the sadness, a normal emotion during a situation of loss. I will build on a foundation of loyalty, trust, and love within myself while finding happiness. And I will not do this alone.

I know that this isn't an "Al-Anon" slogan but the saying appears in one of our readings. This adage reminds me that God, who loves me, has a plan.

### 2024 DISTRICT POSITIONS ARE NOW OPEN

fter three years, the current **PANEL 61** in **District 159** will step down in December. Please think about doing service. Even if you are seasonal, you can still volunteer! The district meetings are in-person and on Zoom.

Each month, a District position will be highlighted in THE BEACON. A description of the open position and the procedures established will appear below. You don't do it alone. There are service sponsors to help the new incoming Chairpersons.

**POSITION:** Archives - The Chairperson is responsible for preserving and maintaining historical documentation, pertaining to our District, that has been collected over the years along with current group information. If you like organizing and cataloging then this job is for you!

- Separate historical from routine correspondence
- Scan items for digital preservation
- Transport supplies and presentations to events
- Find convenient storage locations

**POSITION: Secretary** - As District Secretary, it is my responsibility to attend monthly district meetings in-person or on Zoom if available. During the meeting, I take notes on the agenda, to include attendance, and then type the minutes for the website. I collaborate with the District Representative to insure correctness before forwarding them to the webmaster for publication on our Al-Anon website. I also keep a record of all motions made during the three year panel.

Being secretary has enabled me to learn about the inner workings of our Al-Anon organization. This organization is very important to me as it has helped me to navigate the trials and rewards of living with an alcoholic. I have met many wonderful friends in Al-Anon and cherish the fellowship before and after the meetings. Volunteering and service have always been important to me and I am glad to be of service.

> 50% to District 30% to Area 20% to WSO



he wondrous thing about Al-Anon's Traditions is perfectly stated by Lois W. in Paths to Recovery (B 24) page 133. "Al-Anon holds together by means of a loving understanding among its members. Al-Anon is united - without organization, without management, without chain of command or a set of rules by its members's willingness to be obedient to the unenforceable".

In a perfect world, everyone would always agree and get along and have no conflicts. However, we all know that we don't live in a perfect world. Al-Anon's Tradition Two implies unity, integrity, respect, honor, and dignity under the umbrella of a loving God.

In Reaching for Personal Freedom, (P 92) it is explained that Tradition Two allows us the opportunity to make decisions based on "substantial unanimity". We are able to accomplish this with no one individual holding power over anyone else in the group. We all have a voice and the opportunity to express it without criticism while maintaining mutual respect and trust in our respective Higher Power.

In closing, we lead by example with one authority, a loving God, guiding us to a right decision through a Group conscience.

My wife is back home now and on her way to drinking every day. I look back on that month of tranquility with longing. I love my wife but I'm not ready to make a decision about our relationship. I am ready to renew my commitment to myself and to the program.

So here I am at an Al-Anon meeting sharing what my commitment to myself looks like. Each morning I read page 46 in *Courage to Change* to start the day off on the right track and then my daily readers. I call my sponsor every week. I include my Higher Power throughout my day. I keep the focus on myself. With that I show up for meetings doing a '90 in 90' right now, as well as volunteering in my home group. I am slowly finding my own Serenity a day at a time.

I spoke to my sponsor about what happened and she asked me three questions:

- 1. What's going on underneath this reaction? Why am I feeling what I'm feeling?
- 2. What can I do to make myself feel better; to sooth myself?
- 3. What would recovery look like? Consider the 3 A's-awareness, acceptance and action.

This exercise helped me to think about not changing something outside of me but what to change inside of me.

#### **TIME TO VOTE**

t's time for all AFG group's to start voting for their 2024 GR, Alternate GR, Treasurer, Literature, and a Secretary.

Depending on the group size and format, the group may choose not to fill all positions. (Al-Anon Service Manual pg 57)

This happens every three years. It is part of the turnover process. A three year commitment is doable and at any time if life changes, anyone can step down if need be and the position is available for someone else to enjoy.

**Group Representative** (GR) - is elected by the group to represent the group at our monthly District Meeting and at our twice a year Area Assembly meetings, where they share information of importance. The GR brings that information back to the group. There's usually an **Alternate GR** to assist the GR stepping in to help when the GR is unavailable.

**Treasurer** - is elected by the group to collect and maintain a record of all weekly donations; to distribute quarterly to the District, Area and WSO accordingly as well as pay the group's rent as agreed upon. The Treasurer keeps a reserve on hand for unexpected expenses and helps to send the GR to assemblies as well as reads the Quarterly Appeal to the group.

**Literature** - Chairperson is elected by the group to order and collect money for the sale of Conference Approved Literature; to promote the sale of *THE FORUM* and announce new Al-Anon books.

**Secretary** - is elected by the group to write and maintain the minutes of group business meetings or group conscious decisions. S/he also picks up the mail, keeps up-to-date phone lists, notifies District Group Records of any changes to the group and sends out announcements.

Please consider how important your meeting is to you. Put your name forward for any one of these positions. If you need more information ask your current GR.

Al-Anon cannot work without volunteers.
